

LPG SAFETY TIPS



✓ DO's



At the time of delivery, check whether the Company Seal and Safety Cap is intact



Always place cylinder at ground level, on a flat surface, and in a vertical position



Place gas stove on a platform or table, above the cylinder



When lighting burner, strike match before switching on burner



Wear a cotton apron while cooking



Switch off regulator after every cooking



Check rubber tube regularly for leaks. Change tube every two years



Use only authorized regulator and ensure it is properly fitted



Ensure all parts of installation are in good condition



Get all parts of the installation checked by distributor, once in a year

✗ DON'Ts



Do not keep gas cylinder inside an enclosed compartment



Do not install cylinder near heat source, or expose to rain and dust



Never leave cooking unattended



Do not use any part of your clothing for placing or removing utensils on the stove

In case of Gas leakage

Open all doors and windows immediately

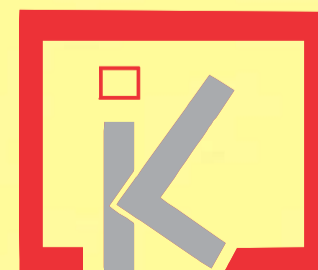
Remove regulator and fix the safety cap on the valve immediately

Do not light matches, lighter etc.

If regulator is in 'ON' position, switch to 'OFF' position immediately

Remove cylinder to an open area and contact your Distributor/ Dealer

Do not switch ON/OFF any electrical fitting inside the house
